Q13. Name any two places where computers are used in daily life. [2 Marks]

Correct Option / Answer:

1. Schools
2. Hospitals (or Banks / Airports / Shops)

Detailed Solution: Computers are widely used in daily life in places like schools (for teaching) and hospitals (for keeping records of patients).

Marking Scheme: Award 1 mark for each correct place named (1 Mark + 1 Mark = 2 Marks).

Q14. What happens on the screen when you perform a right-click on an item? [2 Marks]

Correct Option / Answer: Performing a right-click opens a list of options or a context menu on the screen.

Detailed Solution: Pressing and releasing the right mouse button once displays a popup menu containing options related to the selected item.

Marking Scheme: Award 2 marks for correctly explaining that it opens a list of options/menu.

Q15. What is a mouse pad, and why should we use it? [2 Marks]

Correct Option / Answer: A mouse pad is a soft and flat mat on which the mouse is kept. It helps the mouse move smoothly and keeps it dust-free.

Detailed Solution: Using a mouse pad allows the mouse sensor to track movement accurately while protecting the computer mouse from damage and dirt.

Marking Scheme: Award 1 mark for defining a mouse pad and 1 mark for giving its benefit/use.

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
